## **Abstract**

The key purpose of the research under consideration is to conduct a survey regarding the existence of business incubation services at AMAN Centre for Entrepreneurial Development (CED), IBA Karachi and Center for Entrepreneurial Leadership & Incubation, Sukkur IBA. For this purpose, the key research objectives developed in order to measure the services offered to incubatees by AMAN-CED and CEL & INC incubation centers. Further, objectives is to measure relationship between the services offered to the incubatees at AMAN-CED and CEL & INC incubation centers. Lastly, to measure the similarities and differences in the perceptions of Incubatees and Incubators in terms of services being offered at AMAN-CED and CEL & INC incubation centers.

It has been identified through the reviewed academic literature that business incubator supports the start-up ventures to grow by providing them services, resources and trainings which the incubatees require. However, business incubation field lacks studies which focus on Services of Incubation Centers. In this regard, the theoretical framework of Voisey et al has been used to conduct this research study.

Along with this, it has been examined through primary data analysis that both incubation centers provide offered services to the incubatees. Along with this, there exist correlation among the key services offered by Aman CED and CEL & INC except premises and resources and consulting services have negative co-relation. There is a similarity in the perception of both the Incubatees and Incubators in terms of services being offered at AMAN-CED and CEL & INC Incubation Centers. However, trainings provided to the incubatees in both AMAN-CED and CEL & INC are very few. Therefore, some recommendations have been proposed in the end of the research to enhance the services and skills provided to incubatees at the incubation centers.
