

ABSTRACT

Technical & Vocational education training (TVET) is identified as a master plan to enhance the economic growth of both developed & developing nations, also improve the well-being of life, but in today's time, the technical education of Pakistan is facing different issues like diploma holders and graduate students of TVET institutes facing the problem of unemployment, and they are lacking behind to meet the requirement of industries. The present research used a quantitative methodology, and survey questionnaire for data collection, all the survey responses were entered in SPSS for data analysis. Applied Cronbach's alpha test to check the reliability of the Questionnaire. For better understanding, the results of this research are shown in Pie, Bar, and column charts. This study examined the Current status of TVET institutes, and the linkage between TVET institutes and local Industries, for that purpose conducted skills need assessment from industries, findings of the study are that there is a mismatch between Industries and Technical institutes, and there is no significant relationship between local industries and TVET Institutes in District Shaheed Benazirabad. Finally, the research has proposed a Model for effective utilization of TVET for industrial growth in Shaheed Benazirabad, the recommendations and conclusions were provided at the end for better development and linkage between TVET institutes and Local industries.
