

ABSTRACT

The key aim of the research was to identify impact of education on entrepreneurship intentions among university and vocational students. The research has achieved the developed objectives and aim of the study. For this purpose, the sample universities included – MUET, University of Sindh, LUMHS, SZABIST and Isra University. The vocational institutes included – APTECH, Government Vocational Training Centre (Girls), Government College of Technology and Pilot Social Welfare Complex. The research was based on quantitative methodology and the data was interpreted through SPSS Statistics software version 20.

The findings have determine the impact of education on entrepreneurship intentions among university and vocational students, a comparative study among business, engineering, medical and vocational students. The key findings being obtained so far conclude that the Entrepreneurial Intention among students of University and Vocational Training is significant. There is a positive co-relation between the Education and Entrepreneurial Intention. Type of Institution has a significant impact on the entrepreneurial intention among the students. Students of Vocational Training have more practical knowledge while the students of University only get the theoretical knowledge.
