

ABSTRACT

The vision and main focus of this study is to evaluate the impediments in the implementation of women development projects. It analyzes the objectives of NGOs and goals of NGOs in Hyderabad and also their validity in women development projects. The study focuses on studying programs, implementations achievements of women development projects that are launched by various organizations with their impact on the beneficiaries.

This research has covered the three main NGOs of Hyderabad, Sindh Agricultural and Forestry Workers Coordinating Organization (Safwco), Strengthening Participatory Organization (SPO) is one of the leading NGOs in Pakistan and Sindh Community Foundation (SCF) that are handling many projects regarding women issues. To know the impediments in the implementation of women development projects, study was conducted by using both qualitative and quantitative research methods, the qualitative method was used to describe the thoughts and opinion from respondents while quantitative method was used to test the objectives developed in this study and the data was collected by different techniques such as questionnaire and interviews.

The problems faced by NGOs in Hyderabad in female development projects may be caused by different developmental and social factors such as, education, language, religious, cultural etc. All these factors are incorporated from primary research. The procedures and performances of NGOs in Hyderabad are considered as factors, and are included in the survey questionnaire to predict the most affecting cause of unsatisfactory

results in women development projects in Hyderabad. This research concludes low level of education and religious issues to be the most influential variables followed by infrastructure problems and complex documentation process.

At the end research suggests some points to the NGO sector to enhance their performances in accomplishing women development projects.
